PETYA/NOT PETYA Ransomware Attacks

Details

At OpenText, the security and privacy of our customers' information is our top priority.

OpenText is aware of and has been carefully monitoring the recent news surrounding the PETYA/NOT PETYA ransomware attacks. In an effort to help reduce the risk to our customers, OpenText has proactively reviewed its systems to assess the potential impact of this issue. Based on industry best practices and manufacturer recommendations, we believe OpenText's security posture is currently providing the necessary safeguards and prevention. OpenText has applied patches and protection controls as appropriate. OpenText also utilizes many security tools and services to provide additional layers of protection.

OpenText will continue to take the necessary steps to protect our customers using threat intelligence and advanced monitoring. We have an active threat intelligence program that has established relationships with governments and private organizations to ensure we are actively aware of all developments and findings. At this point we have not been impacted by the PETYA/NOT PETYA ransomware and are continually reassessing our environments based on new available information.
